## Fraud Alert Notice to VCB Customers

Virginia Commerce Bank has just identified a phishing scam targeting VCB customers, that is not an official communication from the Bank. Suspicious emails are being circulated claiming to come from [vcbonline.com](http://vcbonline.com) that falsely state we have temporarily prevented access to your account under the pretext that someone else has tried to access it. It then directs you to run the attached file. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES** should you click on any attachment.

Remember, VCB will never send you an email asking you for passwords, credit card numbers or other sensitive information, nor will we ask you to run an executable file. Please [contact VCB through our secure email](#) or call your local branch to communicate to us about your accounts.
